Tuesday		Forgiveness – Saying sorry and being forgiven	<p>Values for life – p103</p> <p>Introducing Forgiveness. A Christian perspective on forgiveness – Forgiveness is the means by which damaged relationships are restored. It is an act of the will, motivated by love. For Christians, Jesus' death on the cross is the ultimate revelation of God's all forgiving love, and his sacrifice stands as a source of inspiration to forgive others, no matter what the cost.</p> <p><b>Reflecting as a whole school community</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How are children and adults within the school community helped to acknowledge that we all make mistakes and we all need forgiveness from God and each other?</li> <li>• How does the school help all members of the community make amends for their</li> </ul>

Wednesday		Forgiveness – saying sorry and being forgiven	<p>Values for Life P106</p> <p>Introduction – Discuss times when parents have been cross with them and why. Introduce the idea of being forgiven by our parents when we do wrong and how their forgiveness springs from their love for us.</p> <p>The Story of the Prodigal Son – A parable Jesus told about the ways different members of the family behaved. Emphasise the constant love of the father in this story – he was waiting, looking out for his son to return.</p> <p><b>Why do you think Jesus told this story?</b> He wanted people to know how much God loves each individual person and that he is a good and loving father – like the father in the story who never stops loving his son, even though he rejected his father.</p> <p>Draw attention to the fact that the son had to come back to his father and say he was sorry for what he had done for complete forgiveness to be given. As a result, the relationship of father and son could be fully restored.</p>

Thursday		Forgiveness – saying sorry and being forgiven	 <p>Present the PowerPoint about being sorry and thinking about when we need to say sorry and the different ways we can do this. Make links to yesterday's story of the Prodigal son.</p>
