The Jesus storybook Bible page 100 – Ten ways to be perfect (The story of Moses and the Ten commandments)  Read the story above, which is a story from the Old Testament which shows people taking God's love for granted and how He gave the ten commandments to help guide people in how to live.

			The story of the Israelites in the wilderness is about how God led His people out of slavery in Egypt, parted the Red Sea, and guided them through the desert for 40 years. Even though the people often complained, God provided food, water from a rock, and protection with a pillar of cloud by day and fire by night. When they were thirsty, God told Moses to strike a rock with his staff, and water came out.  For 40 years, God gave them just enough food, water, and protection, teaching them to trust Him every day. At Mount Sinai, God gave Moses the Ten Commandments, which were a guide for His people to live by and a reminder to trust and obey Him.  The wilderness journey taught the Israelites to trust God even when things were difficult.  Despite the people's complaints, God consistently provided for their needs, showing His care and love for them.
