	THEME	Learning Intention	Resources/ display
Monday	Thankfulness	Praising God in creation	We are thinking about the theme of thankfulness and how, just by being itself, every part of creation praises God. (Roots and Fruits) Read 'Wonderful Earth' by Nick Butterworth and Mick Inkpen.
Tuesday	Thankfulness	Praising God in creation	Roots and fruits p140 – Read Bob Hartman's story 'Thank you God', a retelling of Psalm 148 which is a song of praise to God in the Bible. <b>Children to take part in actions.</b>
Wednesday	Thankfulness		Roots and Fruits p142 Reflecting
			Refer to the story about creation and Psalm 148 from yesterday's worship, then ask the children 'What are you most thankful for in creation?'
			Children choose adjectives to describe their idea, e.g. sparkling raindrops, deep dark caves. Write these on post it notes for the worship wall.
			Worship team to use these ideas to create a whole school prayer which will be used at the Harvest Festival. (Responding section p142)
