Monday	What is Lent?	<p>Last week was Shrove Tuesday, followed by Ash Wednesday, and this is the beginning of the period of Lent. Today we are going to think about what Lent is and why this is an important period for Christians.</p> <p>Use the Lent powerpoint to explore this.</p>
Tuesday	What is justice?	<p>Ask the children what they know about justice? Can they think of any examples?</p> <p>https://youtu.be/KSBhsEoKYvY?si=oNADWHwoqcyVFp9s Show this video to help explain what Justice is.</p> <p><i>Use the information below to support discussion about what is justice.</i></p> <p>Justice is the concept of fairness, equality, and treating people right according to rules or laws. It ensures everyone gets what they need and deserve, such as sharing toys fairly or following rules. Justice often involves using fair judgment to balance rights and responsibilities, ensuring everyone is treated with respect and honesty.</p> <p><u>Key Concepts of Justice for Children:</u></p> <p>Fairness and Sharing: It means sharing, taking turns, and ensuring everyone gets a fair opportunity.</p> <p>Equality: Treating people the same way, but sometimes it means giving different people different things to make sure everyone has what they need to be comfortable.</p>

		<p>Rules and Rights: Following rules, such as those in games or school, helps keep things fair for everyone.</p> <p>Empathy and Kindness: Justice involves thinking about other people's feelings and needs, not just your own.</p> <p>Making it Right: If something unfair happens (like someone being treated unkindly), justice is about fixing the situation so things feel balanced again</p>
