

Monday	Having trust in others	<p>Values for Life – “The children are introduced to different kinds of trust that we put in others. They also consider the consequences of not being able to trust someone.”</p> <p>Explain to the children that the value we will be thinking about this half term is trust. Trust is very important if a community is to work together properly. There are many different people that we need to be able to trust.</p> <p>Usually we only trust people who we know are worthy of our trust. Trust has to be earned. When someone lets us down it is difficult to trust them again. The following story tells us why.</p> <p>Read ‘The boy who cried wolf’</p> 
Tuesday	Having trust in others	<p>Recap yesterday’s story – Telling lies is one way that someone shows they can’t be trusted. Are there other ways that people show they can’t be trusted?</p> <p>Read the story ‘Can’t you sleep little bear’ (M Waddell, B Firth) that illustrates a relationship of trust. Discuss together the ways that Little Bear demonstrates his trust in Big Bear.</p>
Wednesday	Having trust in others	<p>Using blindfolds try a trust walk. In pairs the children will take turns for one partner to be blindfolded whilst the other leads.</p>
