Monday	Being trustworthy	<p>Values for life p90 "Through the story of Gideon we see how it is important to show trustworthiness in small things in order that greater responsibility can follow."</p> <p>Read the story 'A brave and mighty man' from the Lion storyteller Bible by Bob Hartman.</p> <p>Discuss – God saw that even though he had asked great things of Gideon, he was worthy of trust. This is how we get the word 'trustworthy'. There are times when each of us will be trusted with tasks that must be done. We may be trusted by a parent, a friend or a teacher. Sometimes the tasks will seem small and sometimes they will be very challenging. It is important that we do whatever we agree to do really well, because then people will come to know that we are trustworthy people.</p>
Tuesday	Being trustworthy	<p>Roots and fruits – being trustworthy, not gossiping In the Bible, there is a book of wise sayings called Proverbs. Here's one of them. <i>"No one who gossips can be trusted with a secret, but you can put confidence in someone who is trustworthy."</i> Proverbs 11.13</p> <p>Are you someone who can be trusted? Use the story of Barney and Bella (Two children can read out the script) to reflect that being trustworthy can be difficult. It is always tempting to pass on gossip, especially when we think others will want to hear it. But we need to be people that others can trust. How trustworthy are you?</p>
