What is Child Protection about?

All of the adults around you think that your health, safety and welfare are very important.

In our school, we respect our children and help to protect their rights.

We help children make good educational progress and ensure full inclusion is achieved.

We teach children how to recognise risks in different situations, and how to protect themselves and stay safe.

How will we try to protect children?

We provide a safe environment for children to learn in;

We ensure that children remain safe at school;

We think it is important for our children to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something both at home and at school.

Don't keep it a secret if:

If you think someone is bullying you;

Using words that you do not like or that upset you;

Touching you in places you know are private;

Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol;

Hitting you or hurting you;

Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone.

If you need to talk – we will listen!

You can talk to any adult in school – your teacher, anyone that helps in school if you need to. It is our job to keep you safe – talk to us if you are worried.
